CHAPTER 06

CONCLUSION

As Mac Dougall points out "since journals were the foundation of research their importance had to be revered. In such circumstances it would however blasphemous to deny their continued future existance in the library". The procurement of periodicals in any library depends on the financial provision available and the need of the clientele it has to serve.

As already shown in the study fragmentation of subjects due to specialization resulting in minute fields has resulted in about 50% of the articles on any scientific or technical discipline being published in a vast number of peripheral periodicals while the balance 50% being published in core periodicals. In any special library or university library it is a sheer necessity to order core periodicals and also indexing and abstracting journals.

At the stage of selection of periodical titles for ordering librarians should provide proper guidance to academic and researchers who do the selection. From time to time librarians should conduct usage studies of periodicals and be in a position to indicate highly used, mediumly used and minimumly used periodicals. Periodicals not used at all too should be identified in order to get them deleted in

subsequent orders. The librarians should also indicate whether the periodicals in mention are covered by indexing and abstracting services as inclusion in these facilitate easy retrieval of information. The subscription rates too has to be indicated.

As regards purchasing, the mode of acquisition should With the price discriminations imposed on libraries and ever increasing subscription rates of periodicals it has become impossible for libraries to pay service charges the agents levy. The motive of the libraries is always to reap the maximum benefit of the services of agents who depend mainly on libraries to carry on business as the discounts given to them had been cut to a minimum. Publishers now welcome direct purchasing by libraries and it is upto the publishers to provide a better libraries like giving discounts when service to subscriptions are paid to several periodicals, honouring the claims by the clients speedy delivery of periodicals The orders for the renewal of subscription has to be made in the latter part of the previous year and payments should be made in time lest there would be no gaps in the run.

Regarding the problem of use of periodicals, more guidance has to be given to students or users. The presence of

indexing abstracting journals should be known. Current periodical lists should be displayed. It is worth having current content based on subjects. The librarians should be subject specialists with science based degrees so that they are aware of the subjects and as such are able to provide selective information dissemination services. The current periodicals should be grouped subject-wise and arranged alphabetically.

Back issues should be bound in small volumes so that photocopying in possible. Back issues should be catalogued and shelved in accessible shelves and reading space provided there it self. Adequate reading space should also be provided whereverenecessary, Lanka

More library co-operation is worthwile considering as regards procurement and also filling gaps. Duplication of periodical titles could be avoided by this method, thus saving foreign exchange which is of value to a developing country like ours.

Librarians should give more emphasis to access of information than access to periodicals. On-line access to international data bases is too expensive, and such facilities are not available either, in majority of libraries. CD ROM data bases can be made available through library co-operations as these are expensive. there is library co-operation among health and medical

"HELLIS" and its focal point is the library of the Faculty of Medicine, Colombo. "Health Literature Library and Information Service" or "HELLIS" is a specialised network of health libraries and documentation centres committed to the collection and dissemination of health information. Like wise librarians should form information services in science and engineering fields as well.

The publication of a union list of periodical holdings in university libraries of Sri Lanka by University of Peradeniya Library is a noteworthy step in this direction. As stated by the Librarian of University of Peradeniya in the preface to this publication. "This composite list of current periodicals marks the beginning of the first collaborative effort of the university libraries of Sri Lanka to use their periodical resources collectively" let us hope that there will be information services like HELLIS in engineering and science fields as well.
